I use MISSION GOLD professional grade watercolors.

Cerulean Blue - Yellow Ochre - Shadow Green - Yellow Green - Paynes Grey - Burnt Sienna - Vermillion Ultramarine Blue - Van Dyke Brown - Clear Violet

Large Wash Brush - Flat or Round (Bulletin Stroke preferably) - 3/4"--1" nylon shaved handle #12 Combo Round - #6 Script Liner
